"Middle Easterners see dreams... It's not a new phenomenon! Someone should be referred to the Bible! So many saw dreams.... Angels appearing in dreams or daylight visitations! I am glad Moses, Abraham, Joseph....all saw dreams....Also Peter...The trend continues.

I have tested this. In any setting in the Middle East, ask who has seen a dream? At the very least 50% of hands go up! In any Middle Eastern Christian setting ask (and I have done so)... who has seen a dream of Christ? Again over 50% of hands go up.

And finally ask how many came to faith in Christ because of dream? At least 20% of hands go up! Many will say the dream helped and directed them to search for truth! Over 50%.

But who can prove I have seen a dream or not!?...the only proof is transformation from darkness to light!"
